

Environmental Legislation

Webtec Products Limited (Webtec) is dedicated to complying with the requirements of all applicable environmental legislation and regulations. Based on the information received from our suppliers the following statements are issued:

Directive EC/1907/2006 REACH Legislation

Our products are non-chemical and under normal and reasonable foreseeable circumstances will not release any chemical substances. Our manufacturing division does not manufacture or import substances concerned by REACH, therefore in the terms of REACH we are so called 'Downstream users'. It is therefore our understanding that Webtec are not obliged to register or required to create safety data sheets under REACH legislation.

The aim of REACH is to improve the protection of human health and the environment through the better and earlier identification of the properties of chemical substances. Webtec consider this to be of utmost importance and as required will provide customers with information about chemicals of 'very high concern' used in our products; analysis shows that there are no such substances.

Directive 2011/65/EU & European Delegated Directive (EU)2015/863 - Restriction of the use of certain Hazardous Substances in Electrical and Electronic Equipment (RoHS)

Webtec is fully compliant with the European Union Restriction of the Use of Certain Hazardous Substances in Electrical and Electronic Equipment ("RoHS") Directive. The RoHS directive prohibits the sale of electronic equipment containing certain levels of hazardous substances such as lead, cadmium, mercury, hexavalent chromium, polybrominated biphenyls ("PBB") and polybrominated diphenylethers ("PBDE") in the European Union.

Directive 2012/19/EC on Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment (WEEE)

All Webtec hydraulic components with electrical or electronic control can be returned to the manufacturer, Webtec Products Ltd, for recycling according to the conditions laid out in the WEEE directive. We are registered with a compliance scheme (Electrolink), our WEEE registration number is **WEE/FE2712VR**.

Perfluorooctanoic acid (PFOA), its salts and PFOA related substances covered by Regulations (EU) 2020/784, (EU) 2019/1021 and (EC) 1907/2006

All Webtec products conform to the above amended regulations in respect of concentrations limits on perfluorooctanoic acid (PFOA), its salts and PFOA-related compounds.

Persistent Organic Pollutants (POPs) covered by Regulation (EU) 2019/1021

In the manufacture of all products supplied by Webtec, persistent organic pollutants listed in annex I, III or IV of Regulation (EU) 2019/1021, or raw materials containing these substances are not used as intentionally added components.
